Sharing the chalice the Parochial Church Council has decided that the chalice will again be shared with everyone, so all may receive the consecrated wine if they wish to, but no-one should feel they should. Some may prefer the practice of intinction rather than drinking directly from the chalice, dipping the communion bread in the wine, but this should be done very carefully so fingers do not go in the wine.
